

DR. MARTIN JANATA

Dr. Martin Janata is a neurosurgeon with more than 25 years of experience in spinal surgery.

He completed his full neurosurgical training at Hospital České Budějovice (Czech Republic) and further expanded his expertise through fellowships and observerships at several renowned European spine centers, including Schulthess Klinik Zurich and Kantonsspital Chur in Switzerland. He subsequently continued his career in Germany at the prestigious spine center of Zentralklinik Bad Berka, specializing in spinal deformity surgery, and later served as Deputy Head of the Spine Department at Schön Klinik Hamburg-Eilbek.

A particularly valuable part of his professional development was the collaboration with Prof. Bertagnoli, who is widely regarded as one of the pioneers of motion-preserving and non-fusion techniques in spine surgery. This experience significantly influenced Dr. Janata's surgical philosophy and further strengthened his focus on biomechanically sound alternatives to spinal fusion.

Currently, Dr. Janata works in private practice in Bavaria, Germany, and maintains close international collaboration.

His main areas of interest include cervical and lumbar disc replacement and other motion-preserving spinal procedures. He strongly advocates the principles of spinal biomechanics and anterior spine surgery, believing that non-fusion techniques can provide superior long-term outcomes in appropriately selected patients.
